Context:

Reporting directly to the Field Coordinator the incumbent will have to provide general counselling and support to unaccompanied minors; he/she will be assigned to and support the immediate referral of children in need. He/she will work closely with the project coordinator in line with the project.

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

- Designing and implementing educational programs and enhancing teaching activities
- Designing educational and entertainment programs for productive spirit cultivation
- Observe and monitor minors during play activities.
- Keep individual records, including daily observations and information about activities.
- Assist and/or instruct children in health and personal habits.
- Perform any other duties as may be assigned.

Required Qualifications and Experience

Education

- Bachelor's degree (or equivalent or higher) in Early Childhood Education, Pedagogy, Child Care Services Management or a related field from an accredited academic institution; or
- High school degree/certificate with two years of relevant professional experience.

Experience

- Familiar with direct assistance to migrants and/or refugees;
- Experience in working in a multi-cultural environment;
- Proficient use of commonly used IT equipment and the appropriate software solutions.
- At least two years of previous relevant work experience;
- Experience in an international environment;
- Computer literacy in standard software applications (MS Office, etc)
